(not private, not alone, not one at a time)

Everyone watches and learns together

Kids and parents look forward to seeing each other

The whole time is everyone's lesson; kids take turns at instrument instruction while all learn

Parents understand other children's progress,

Personal attachments across the group, a sense of sharing, and fun enhance learning

Kids become comfortable with an audience so recitals are natural and easy

This is Dr. Shin'ichi Suzuki's lesson format for students' weekly lessons

In lessons together

Suzuki Method lessons are Masterclass style

Home studio same as at Institutes

Add Suzuki triangles along the outside of the circle, points out,

Suzuki parent-child-teacher triangles along the Suzuki Circle around the Suzuki Triangle

A shining sun
